RESOLUTION NO. 18-06

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL'S SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 930 WHICH IS LEGISLATION TO CREATE THE ATLANTA-REGION TRANSIT LINK (ATL) AND TO AUTHORIZE REFERENDUMS FOR TAXATION FOR TRANSPORTATION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia (the "City") is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council seek to offer its support of HB930 signed by the Governor on May 3, 2018; and

WHEREAS, this law is designed to authorize referendums for taxation in the 13 metro-area counties in an effort to increase options for mass transit throughout the metro Atlanta area; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are in support of transportation efforts of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize this legislation is necessary for the future growth, economic development, and alleviation of traffic issues in the region; and

WHEREAS, the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City and this State will be positively impacted by the adoption of this Resolution; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia that the City fully supports HB 930.
