**RESOLUTION 18-23**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON'S MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO  
WAIVE FEES FOR CALVARY BAPTIST CHURCH; TO PROVIDE FOR  
SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL ALL CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO  
PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council is committed to protecting and promoting the public health, safety and general welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the City passed a Resolution to govern the donation of city resources and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been notified that a leak at the Calvary Baptist Church has resulted in an estimated \$10,005.90 water bill owed to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, although the leak has been repaired, the church is unable to pay the increased water bill from the leak; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the City's desire to reduce the church's water bill to \$3,895.00 as a courtesy to the church; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the City's best interest to provide this accommodation to the church in exchange for its service to the Hampton community.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton grants the City Manager the authority to reduce the water bill of Calvary Baptist Church to \$3,895.00 and forgive the balance thereof.
