WHEREAS, a forensic audit is the process of reviewing the financial statements to determine if they are accurate and lawful; and

WHEREAS, a forensic audit is also an examination and evaluation of an entity's financial information for use as evidence in court or to prosecute a party for fraud, embezzlement or other financial claims; and

WHEREAS, the City will need to procure the professional services of an auditor to conduct said forensic audit; and

WHEREAS, a preliminary research of the cost for forensic audits ranges from \$____ to \$____; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to authorize the City Manager to procure the services of an auditor to conduct a forensic audit of the City's financial statements in an amount not to exceed \$_____.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to procure the services of a professional auditor in an amount not to exceed \$_____ for the purposes of conducting a forensic audit of the City's financial statements.


