**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City"), located wholly within Henry County, is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into an agreement with Henry County and the other cities that make up Henry County to jointly participate in the review and update of the Comprehensive Plan and Future Land Use Map (hereinafter "FLUM") facilitated by the Atlanta Regional Commission (hereinafter "ARC"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (hereinafter "DCA") requires the Henry County/Cities Joint 2030 Comprehensive Plan and associated FLUM to be updated by October 31, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the City completed the update of its comprehensive plan and FLUM with assistance from ARC on August 29, 2018; and



SO RESOLVED, this 9<sup>th</sup> day of Oct., 2018.


