RESOLUTION NO. 18-29

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A PRE-APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE LAND AND WATER CONVERSATION FUND; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia is the Mayor and Council (hereinafter "City") thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City is entering into Phase II of the Hampton Community Park project and is in need of additional funding to supplement the city's expenses; and

WHEREAS, there is funding available from the Land and Water Conservation Fund (hereinafter "LWCF") hosted by the National Park Service for which the City can apply; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to apply for \$100,000.00 of funding; and

WHEREAS, an application is needed to apply for such funding and the City Manager or his designee has the authority to complete any and all necessary application documents to apply for the LWCF funding; and

WHEREAS, the City is aware of and certifies that in the event the City is recommended for said funding, the City will be responsible for fifty (50) percent of the total project cost;

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, that the City Manager or his designee is authorized to move forward with due diligence in applying for the above-referenced LWCF funding for Phase II of the Hampton Community Park project.
