RESOLUTION NO. 19-18

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to procure professional services to have the City's water system monitored and tested by a Class III Environmental Protection Department (hereinafter "EPD") Certified Water Operator; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these services are needed immediately in order for the City to comply with EPD regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that ClearWater Solutions ("CWS") is the best use of City funds for the monitoring and testing; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending that the City award a professional services contract to CWS at the rate of \$85 per hour as evidenced in the attached October 29, 2019 letter, incorporated by reference at Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the City's best interest to authorize the Council to award the contract to CWS in order to assist the City in coming into compliance with EPD's water system regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the Mayor or his designee to enter into said agreement.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council awards a professional services agreement to CWS for the purpose of EPD water system monitoring and testing and the Mayor or his designee has the authority to sign the same.


