RESOLUTION NO. 2019-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON'S MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT FOR THE CITY CLERK APPOINTMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia (the "City") is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.13 of the Hampton Charter grants the Mayor and City Council the authority to appoint a city clerk who shall not be a councilmember; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appointed Melissa Brooks as City Clerk on October 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the citizens and for the efficient operation of city government to continue with said appointment through a contractual relationship with Ms. Brooks; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton City Council approves the issuance of an employment contract to the City Clerk; authorizes the City Attorney to draft all documents necessary to facilitate the agreement; and, authorizes the Mayor to sign the contract.


