RESOLUTION NO. 19-20

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and
WHEREAS, the City desires to make technology enhancements by running fiber optic wiring
from City Hall to city-owned building that houses the City's Public Works department (collectively
hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that ComTech Fiber is the best use of City funds for the completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City staff is recommending that the City award a contract not to exceed \$88,000.00 to ComTech Fiber for completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to authorize the Council to award the contract to ComTech Fiber and authorize the Mayor or his designee to sign the same;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council awards a contract not to exceed \$88,000.00 to ComTech Fiber for the completion of the Project and the Mayor or his designee has the authority to sign the same.
