RESOLUTION NO. 2021-03

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton is governed by the Mayor and Council (“City”); and

WHEREAS, the City, by resolution, created a Main Street Advisory Board (“Board”) to assist the Main Street Director with projects and fundraising for the City’s Main Street and downtown enhancement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the focal area of its duties, it is the desire of the Board to expand its boundaries to cover a larger portion of the downtown Hampton area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 15-01 in January 2015 designating and defining the Main Street district; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City’s best interest to now expand said Main Street District to include all that area within Resolution 15-01, this boundary description encompasses the entire Main Street District to date; and

The Main Street boundary limit west of Norfolk Southern railroad begins at the intersection of Oak Street and West Main Street to Central Avenue and includes all properties along West Main Street south from Central Avenue to approximately 1,000 feet south of Woolsey Road. Westerly the boundary extends from West Main Street and includes properties along Woodlawn Avenue to Central Avenue and Central Avenue to West Main Street and all properties within along Georgia Avenue, Oak Street, and College Street.

The boundary limit east of Norfolk Southern railroad begins at 58 East Main Street and includes all properties along East Main Street south to GA Hwy 20. Easterly the boundary extends from GA Hwy 20 to East King Road and East King Road to McDonough St, and North on Derrick Avenue to Elm Street and west to East Main Street and all properties within along West King Road, Daniel Street, George Street, Rosenwald Drive, Magnolia Parkway, Plum Blossom lane, McDonough Street, James Street, Cherry Street, Tom Eason Drive, and Barham Street.

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, this expansion of the Main Street District shall be effective immediately; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the Main Street District shall be amended and expanded to all for all that

area described herein and in Resolution 15-01.
