**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-06**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia ("City"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council is tasked with protecting and promoting the health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton; and

**WHEREAS**, the Livable Centers Initiative ("LCI") has opened its 2021 application; and

**WHEREAS**, the LCI program is a reimbursable grant program administered by the Atlanta Regional Commission ("ARC") to encourage a diversity of housing, employment commercial and shopping land uses, to enhance access to a range of travel modes, and to foster public-private partnerships and sustained community support; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to apply for the LCI program committing to the LCI Goals and willingness to participate in any studies and implementation recommendations; and


**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the City shall make an application to the 2021 LCI Grant Program and commit its own funds of no less than \$20,000.00 to ensure eligibility for an award. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate any and all funds to support this application and the City Manager or his designee is authorized to sign any and all documents to make this application and to accept the award, if granted.


