RESOLUTION NO. 2021-14

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE HAMPTON DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN ADOPTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City activated a Development Authority (hereinafter "HDA") in Resolution No. 20-23 on August 11, 2020; and


WHEREAS, in consideration of providing funding to the new HDA and to ensure accountability, the City desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") with the HDA; and

WHEREAS, the IGA attached hereto and incorporated by reference shall be approved for execution by the Mayor and take effect immediately; and

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, and by the authority thereof adopt and approve the IGA, attached hereto and incorporated by reference, with the HDA and authorize the Mayor to sign on behalf of the City to be effective immediately.




