RESOLUTION NO. 20-01

A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE PROVISION OF PLANNING AND ZONING SERVICES AND TO REMOVE THE CITY APPOINTED MEMBER FROM THE HENRY COUNTY ZONING ADVISORY BOARD; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia (the “City”) is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council is a party to a Service Delivery Strategy Agreement (“SDS”) and intergovernmental agreement (“IGA”) with Henry County (“County”) for the provision of planning and zoning services (“P&Z”); and

WHEREAS, the current SDS Agreement provides for the County to provide P&Z to the City and said cost would be assessed in the County millage paid by City residents; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the SDS Agreement, a member of the County’s Zoning Advisory Board (“ZAB”) would include a citizen of Hampton appointed by the City’s Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the City and County are currently in litigation regarding the SDS Agreement as it is time for renewal; and

WHEREAS, the City has informed the County that in the new SDS Agreement, the County will no longer provide P&Z services to the City; and

WHEREAS, while the renewed agreement has not been finalized, the City is moving forward with providing its own P&Z services and no longer needs the County for P&Z; and

WHEREAS, the City will seek to have its millage adjusted to reflect said change and continue to litigate the SDS Agreement to ensure it reflects this change; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this change, the City no longer requires a citizen to serve on the County's ZAB.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia that City will provide its own P&Z services and hereby terminates the provision of P&Z from the County, thereby removing its appointee, Chris Moore, from the County ZAB, effective immediately.


