RESOLUTION NO. 20-33

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton purchased 32 Barnett Street, a parcel of Property bearing a street address of 32 Barnett Street, Hampton, Georgia and Parcel I.D. H03 03010000 (hereinafter "Property") intending to use it for a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Charter Section 6.34, it has been determined that the Property is no longer needed for a public purpose and retaining the property has no readily ascertainable monetary value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in its best interest to place the Property for sale by way of a request for sealed bids in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 36-37-6; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to execute and deliver all contracts and other documents necessary to sell the Property on behalf of the City; and


NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to cause a sale of the Property in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 36-37-6 by way of sealed bids, and upon sale of the Property and receipt of the proceeds from the sale, the proceeds shall be deposited into the City's General Fund.


