RESOLUTION NO. 2020-34

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A PAID PARKING POLICY AT THE OLD CITY SHOP; TO ESTABLISH A PARKING RATE SCHEDULE; TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City owns property on Oak Street, commonly known as the Old City Shop which is vacant and not used for any purpose; and

WHEREAS, there have been concerns regarding parking in the downtown; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to address these concerns with allowing paid parking long-term and daily at the Old City Shop; and

WHEREAS, a policy attached hereto at Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference is hereby established to create and regulate such parking allowances and which may be revised by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council.



Long-Term/Daily Parking Policy

Old City Shop Surface Lot Inside Fenced Area

Located in downtown Hampton, GA on Tom Eason Blvd.

Open 24/7 - Business Hours: 9:00AM to 5:00PM After hours access provided through Hampton Police Department (Contact Number)

Cash and Credit Cards are accepted at City Hall during regular business hours: 9 am- 5 pm, Monday through Friday.

Rates per Vehicle:

Daily or any part thereof- \$1.00

Long Term- \$30.00 per month and \$1.00 per additional day

Long and short term parking requires a permit to be issued by the City of Hampton. Payment due at issuance of permit. Permitted spaces will be identified and description issued with permit. No vehicles determined by the City of Hampton to be junk or beyond repair will be allowed. No vehicles exceeding GVWR of 26,000 lbs. will be permitted. The City of Hampton is not responsible for any damage or loss to vehicles or content. After hour access is dependent upon available personnel.
