RESOLUTION NO. 2020-39

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO THE CENTRAL GEORGIA EMC APPLICATION FOR THE TRANSFER OF RETAIL ELECTRIC SERVICE SELECT PREMISES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia is the Mayor and Council thereof (hereinafter "City"); and

WHEREAS, the City participates in the Georgia electric membership cooperative to provide electricity to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Central Georgia EMC and the City wish to enter into a transfer of retail electric service for the select premises as evidenced in the attached applications and corresponding maps (attached hereto at Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference); and

WHEREAS, the transfer of territory contemplates approval of a third-party contract; and

WHEREAS, the applications are executed pursuant to Georgia Territorial Electric Service Act and is not intended for any change in territorial assignments; and


WHEREAS, the attached applications would allow for Central Georgia EMC to service the referenced developments in their entirety to prevent the duplication of service; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor shall have the authority to execute the applications and sign any and all subsequent agreements to complete this transfer of retail electric service provided that the third-party contract is approved.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, that the Mayor shall have the authority to execute the attached applications and corresponding documents to complete the transfer of retail electric service for the select premises provided that the third-party contract to complete the transfer is approved.

SO RESOLVED, this 8th day of December 2020.


