**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-17**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton has reviewed the bids in response to the City's desire to  
install a roundabout at the East King Road and Floyd Road intersection ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that McLeRoy, Inc. is the most responsive with a cost  
bid for the Project as listed in **Exhibit "A"** attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the City staff is recommending that the City award the ITB #2021-100 contract  
to McLeRoy, Inc. to perform work on the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City Charter § 2.32(4), the Mayor has authority to sign City  
contracts upon Council's approval; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the City's best interest to authorize the City Manager to contract with  
McLeRoy, Inc. as the successful bidder and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract; and

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the City Council awards the ITB  
#2021-100 contract to McLeRoy, Inc., authorizes the City Manager to enter into contract  
negotiations with McLeRoy, Inc., and authorizes the Mayor to sign the contract.


