WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council is committed to committed to protecting and promoting the public health, safety and general welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City is required by the State to update its Capital Improvement Element ("CIE") with the Atlanta Regional Commission ("ARC") and/or Georgia Department of Community Affairs (hereinafter "DCA"); and

WHEREAS, the CIE is a component of a comprehensive plan which sets out projected needs for system improvements during a planning horizon established in the comprehensive plan and includes a schedule of capital improvements that will meet the anticipated need for system improvements, and a description of anticipated funding sources for each required improvement.

WHEREAS, the CIE deadline is approaching for the plan's update; and

WHEREAS, the City to authorized and it is in the City's best interest for the Community Development Department to draft, submit, and conduct all related assignments with respect to the timely submission of the City's CIE to the DCA and/or ARC; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted public hearings to receive and incorporate comments from Hampton citizens on the CIE;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Hampton authorizes the Community Development Department to transmit the City of Hampton's CIE as a portion of the Comprehensive Plan, as revised with citizen comment to the DCA and ARC by the State imposed deadline.
