**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-26**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City Code § 2-33, the Mayor created and appointed members to the Youth Council Committee for the purpose of oversight of the Youth Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved the appointments and the scope of the committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the committee's duties, any litigation on the scope of its duties, and the times, places and periods of time for which the committee may operate shall be determined by the mayor with the concurrence of the council; and

**WHEREAS**, in the past, the City Council approved the Youth Council Committee meeting schedule for the ensuing term; and

**WHEREAS**, the meeting schedule requires amending as the Youth Council Committee desires to meet outside of the approved schedule and meet as the needs of the Youth Council arises which may be more often than the previously approved schedule; and

**WHEREAS**, the Youth Council Committee has determined a need to set a meeting schedule that is least restrictive and which is subject to change without much notice; and

**WHEREAS**, any meetings held by the Youth Council Committee will be published and noticed as required by law and any cancellation of meetings will be advertised to the public.


**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, the Youth Council Committee establishes that the Committee will meet as needed, no less than six times per calendar year and that all meetings will be properly advertised as specially called meetings by the City Clerk.

**SO RESOLVED**, this 17 day of August, 2021.


