RESOLUTION NO. 2025-53

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton is a taxing authority; and

WHEREAS, the millage rate is the tax rate used to calculate ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton is required by its Charter and Georgia to set the millage rate in time for the mailing of the tax bills; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton is required to rollback its millage rate to offset the City's share of Local Option Sales Tax (hereinafter "LOST") in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 48-8-91 and may allow for a rollback to offset an increase as a result of the revaluation of the County's digest; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton's 2025 net digest for all personal and real property is \$463,458,809 after all applicable rollbacks; and

WHEREAS, in the City's 2023 special election residents voted in favor of homestead exemptions for residents who own and occupy their primary residence; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton's millage for personal and real property for calendar year ending December 31, 2025 is net 4.995 mills.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, the calendar year 2025 millage rate is set at net 4.995 mills and those homestead exemptions that apply to residents of the City of Hampton who own and occupy their primary residence shall be enforced.


