**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-61**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia ("City"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council is tasked with protecting and promoting the health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton is awarded funding from the Georgia Department of Transportation an agency of the State of Georgia, hereinafter called the "DEPARTMENT", for Transportation Facility Improvements identified as PI# 0021212 and West King Road Connector – Pedestrian Bridge, hereinafter called the "PROJECT"; and

**WHEREAS**, the DEPARTMENT is providing the City with the Project Framework Agreement (PFA) detailing Preconstruction Engineering commitments for the PROJECT; and

**WHEREAS**, the DEPARTMENT shall participate in the PROJECT by funding all or certain portions of the PROJECT costs for the preconstruction engineering (design) activities; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City Charter 2.32(4), the mayor has the authority to sign City contracts upon Council approval; and

**WHEREAS**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, accepts the DEPARTMENT Transportation Facility Improvements award and authorizes execution of PFA, as presented to the City Council on September 9, 2025.

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by a majority this 9th day of September, 2025.
