**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-011**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia ("City"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council is tasked with protecting and promoting the health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is a member of the Henry County ("County") Transportation Safety Action Taskforce ("Taskforce"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Taskforce's goal is to develop a city-county joint transportation safety action plan with the cities within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, without a transportation safety action plan setting a vision of zero-death and zero-serious injury in place, the City of Hampton does not qualify for any federal safety improvement implementation grants; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton desires to join this planning project and will benefit by receiving a list and a map of high-crash and high-injury locations in its jurisdiction and a prioritized list of road safety improvement projects which Hampton can use to apply for safety improvement implementation grants; and

**WHEREAS**, a federal grant is paying 80% of the \$245,000 plan development cost; and

**WHEREAS**, the local governments are sharing the 20% local match which comes to \$9,800 per government.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the City shall participate in the Taskforce and join the Henry County Transportation Safety Action Plan with a \$9,800.00 contribution.


