

**WHEREAS**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the City shall make an application to the FY26 CDS Appropriations Request of \$3,000,000.00 on the city's behalf. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to sign any and all documents to make this application and to accept the award, if granted, as presented to the City Council on March 25, 2024.
