Agenda Item 10.I: Consideration and Action to approve RES.2025-29 to estimate the city's 2025 Millage Rate in accordance with HB92 and HB581; to provide for revocation of conflicting Resolutions.

**Background/Summary:**

The city is required by its Charter to set the millage rate. With the passing of HB92 and HB581 the millage rate is required to be estimated prior to the County Tax Assessor's distribution of the digest. The city's actual millage will be passed by ordinance, this resolution authorizes the city manager to transmit the city's estimated millage to the County's Tax Assessor.

Hampton's estimated roll back millage rate for the 2025 Property Tax Digest will be 5.5 mills, the same millage rate it levied on the 2024 Property Tax Digest.

RESOLUTION NO. **2025-29**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON'S MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO ESTIMATE ITS 2025 MILLAGE RATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH HB92 AND HB581; TO PROVIDE FOR REVOCATION OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton is a taxing authority;

**WHEREAS**, the millage rate is the tax rate used to calculate ad valorem taxes;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hampton is required by its Charter Section 6.11 to set the millage rate;

**WHEREAS**, the millage rate is required by HB92 and HB581 to be estimated prior to the County Tax Assessor's distribution of the digest; and;

**WHEREAS**, the setting of the actual millage will be passed by ordinance; however, this resolution shall authorize the City Manager to transmit its estimated millage to the County's Tax Assessor; and


**WHEREAS**, Hampton's estimated roll back millage rate for the 2025 Property Tax Digest will be 5.5 mills, the same millage rate it levied on the 2024 Property Tax Digest; and

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton,

1. The estimated millage rate is set at 5.5 mills;
2. The City Manager shall submit this estimation to the County; and
3. The City shall set its actual millage rate by ordinance pursuant to City Charter 6.11.
