RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 44

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT PROGRAM; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) recently announced the availability of \$982 million in grant funds through the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Program and,

WHEREAS, a successful SS4A application will result in the implementation of the East King Street Realignment project that was proposed in the City and Henry County Trail Plan, Transportation Plan, King, George, and Daniel Street LCI Study; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton has the legal authority and the institutional, managerial, and financial capacity to ensure the 20% local matching requirement is met and adequate use of grant funding in line with SS4A program requirements; and

WHEREAS, in the event of a successful grant application, the city may enter a grant agreement with the USDOT for the above-referenced project, and will comply with all applicable laws and regulations as stated in all contract agreements; and


BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, approves this resolution and supports the pursuit of Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Grant funding and authorizes staff to prepare and submit the necessary application materials.


