RESOLUTION NO. 2023-04

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council is tasked with protecting and promoting the health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton owns and maintains Coley Park; and

WHEREAS, in the maintenance and management of Coley Park, the City allows the public to use the park for softball and baseball practices and tournaments; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is necessary to install lighting at the park for maximum security for its users; and

WHEREAS, the upgrades to Coley Park were approved as projects in both SPLOST IV and V; and

WHEREAS, there are funds remaining in SPLOST IV and funds existing in SPLOST V to move forward with the lighting project; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined, after engaging in the State of Georgia's contract program, that Musco Sports Lighting, LLC ("Contractor") is the best use of taxpayer funds for the installation of the lighting at Coley Park; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary agreements with Contractor for the lighting project at Coley Park; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council authorizes the Finance Director to make the appropriate budget appropriations from SPLOST IV and V to issue payment according to the agreement with Contractor; and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the City Manager is authorized to contract with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC to install the necessary lighting on the fields at Coley Park and the Finance Director is authorized to appropriate the funds to fund said contract.


