RESOLUTION NO. 2023-11

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY, LISTED ON EXHIBIT A, TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS PROPER DISPOSAL EITHER BY AUCTION OR OTHER METHODS PURSUANT TO THE CITY'S ORDINANCES AND STATE LAWS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia is the Mayor and Council (hereinafter "City") thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City's purchasing policies (adopted October 2014) provide discussion and guidance on the purchase, sale or surplus of property belonging to the city, not needed for public use or that may have become unsuited for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has provided a list of City surplus items to the City Manager, attached as **Exhibit "A"** to this resolution and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Public Works Director have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to surplus said item(s) and have requested that said item(s) become surplus and disposed of in the most appropriate manner.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the items listed on **Exhibit A**, attached to this resolution, be declared surplus and hereby gives authority to the City Clerk to cause the items to be disposed of either by auction or in the most appropriate manner in accordance with City and State law.

SUBJECT: Surplus of City-Owned Vehicles and Equipment

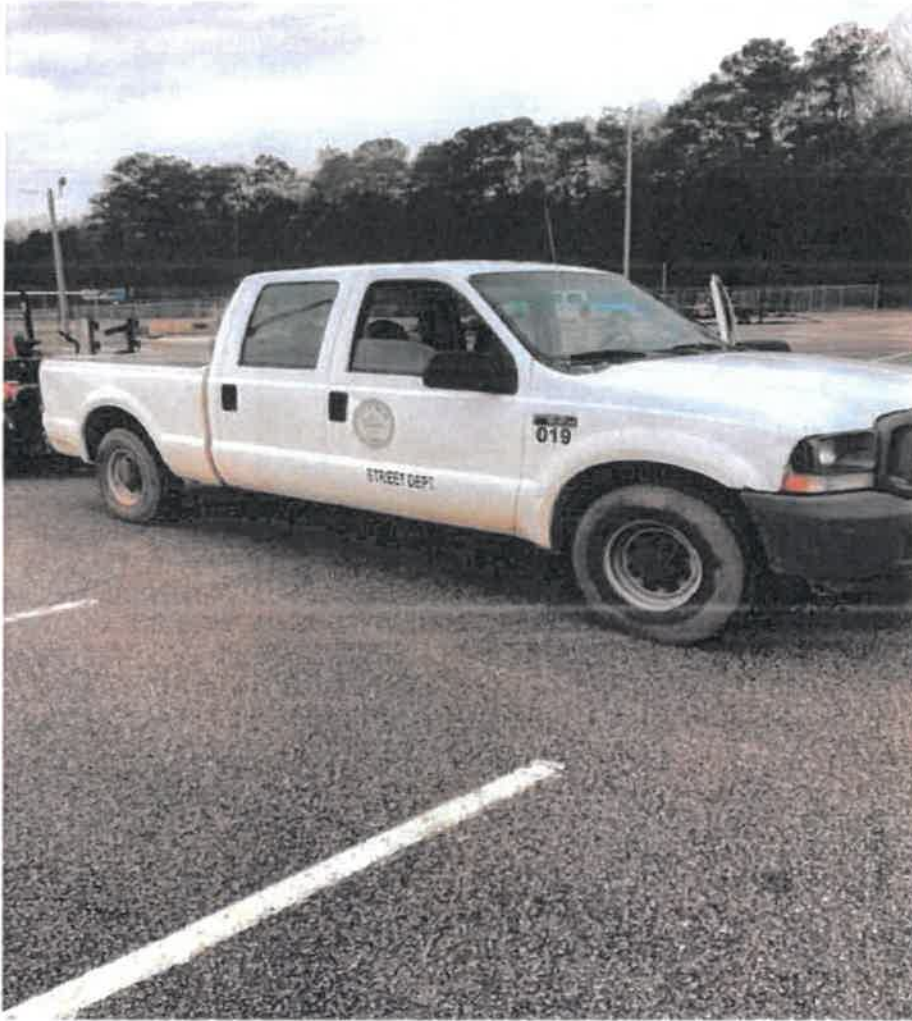
City Manager Cohilas:

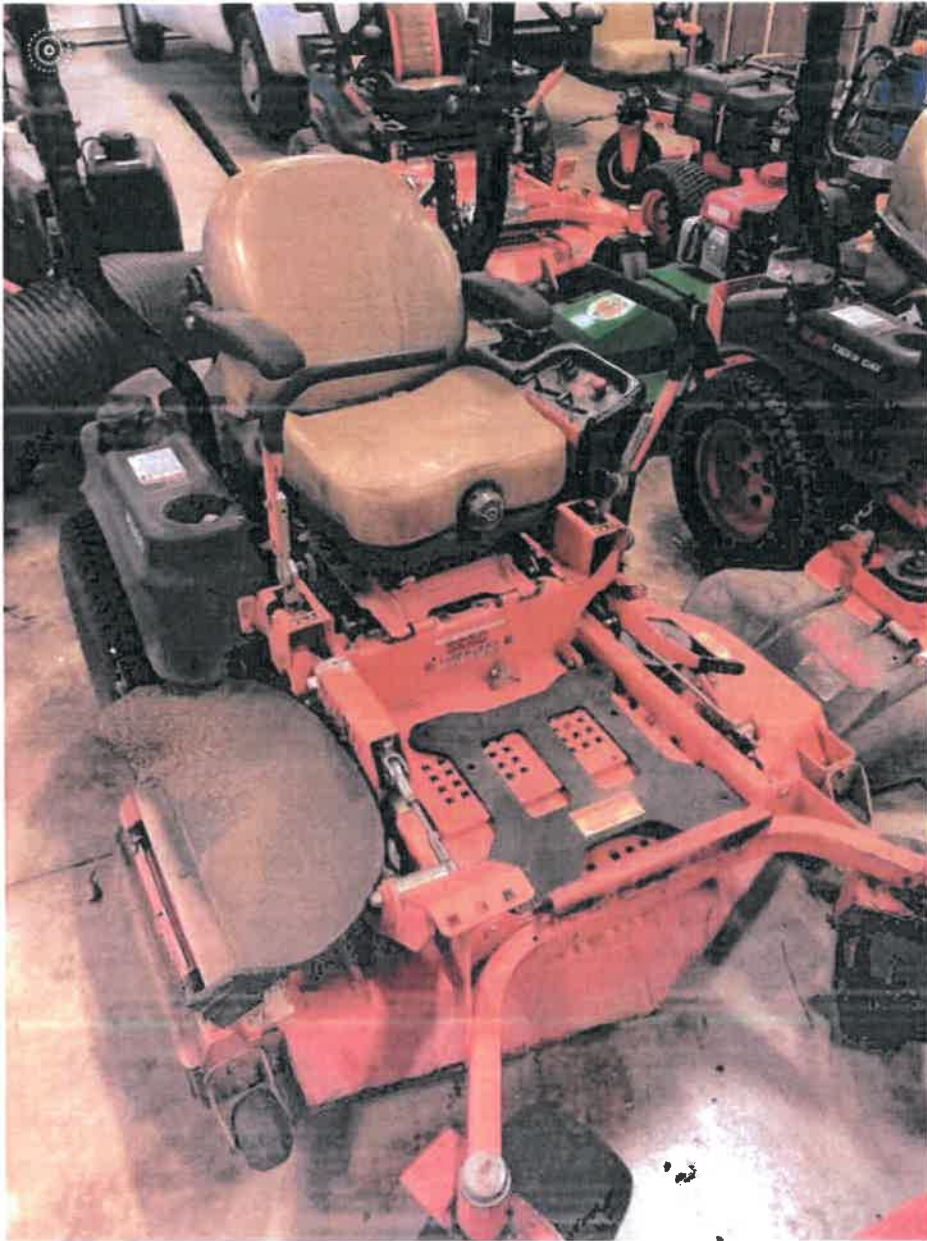






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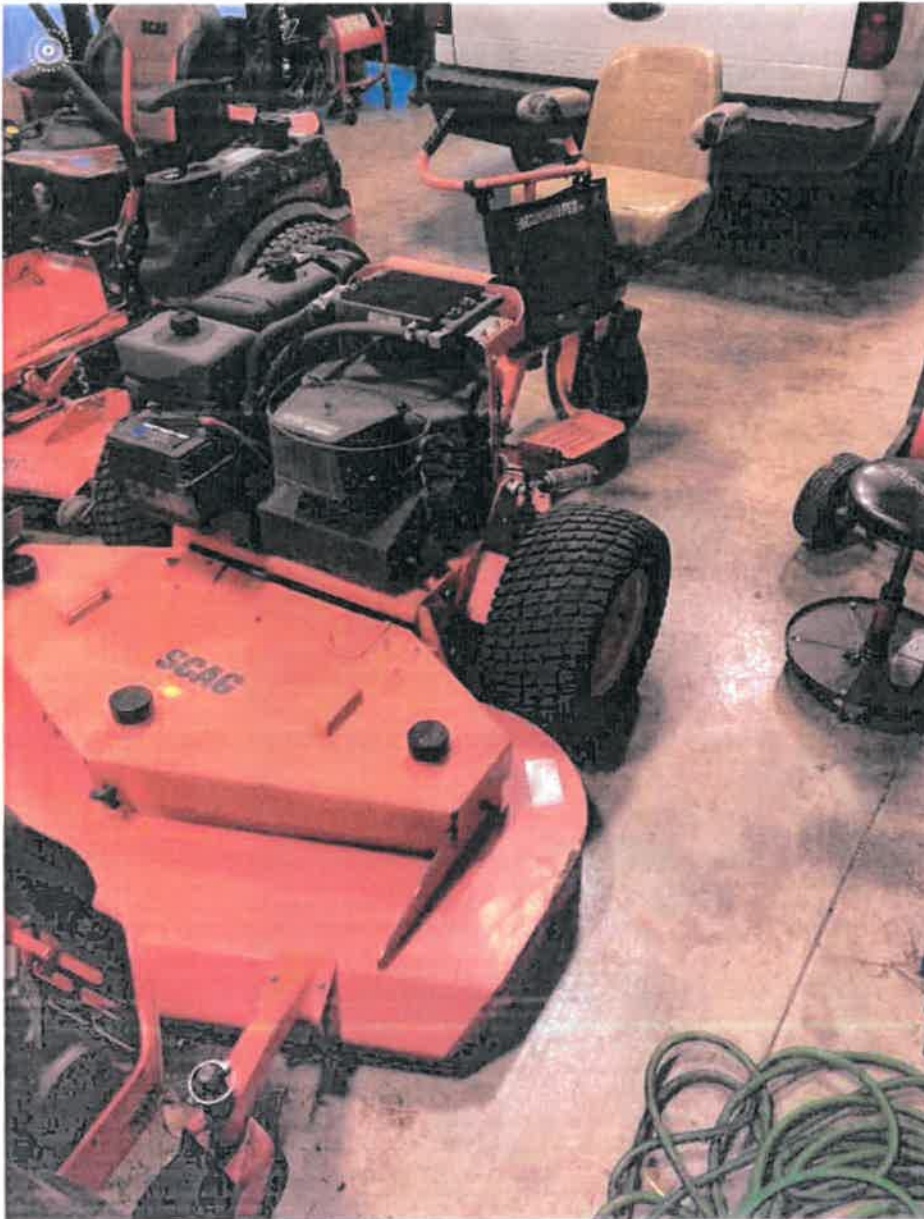
