WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton has reviewed the proposals in response to the City's
desire to purchase uniforms for the public works department ("Service"); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that T&T Uniforms South, Inc. is the most responsive
with a cost proposal for the Service as listed in **Exhibit "A"** attached and incorporated by
reference; and

WHEREAS, the City staff is recommending that the City award the RFP #2023-400 contract
to T&T Uniforms South, Inc. to provide the Service; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter § 2.32(4), the Mayor has authority to sign City
contracts upon Council's approval; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to authorize the City Manager to negotiate with
T&T Uniforms South, Inc. as the successful bidder and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract;
and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council awards the RFP
#2023-400 contract to T&T Uniforms South, Inc, authorizes the City Manager to enter into contract
negotiations with T&T Uniforms South, Inc, and authorizes the Mayor to sign the contract.
