RESOLUTION NO. 2023-36

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are tasked with protecting and promoting the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton Community Development Department desires to engage the private sector to facilitate online services for planning and zoning, development and building plan review, permits, and inspections; and

WHEREAS, the City evaluated permitting software for its ability to simplify processes and modernize citizen services while increasing productivity and reducing customer wait times; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that GovWell Technologies Inc. provides the most compatible software for services outlined; and

WHEREAS, the annual cost will not exceed \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter § 2.32(4), the Mayor has authority to sign City contracts upon Council's approval; and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council enters into contract with GovWell Technologies, Inc. for planning and zoning, development and building plan review, permits, and inspections, authorizes the City Manager to negotiate the contract with GovWell Technologies, Inc., and authorizes the Mayor to sign said contract.


