**WHEREAS**, the City's Main Street Board and Hampton Day, Inc. host activities to commemorate Hampton Day; and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks to support and partner with the Main Street Board and Hampton Day, Inc. to annually commemorate Hampton Day; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hampton Day celebrations are open to all citizens and visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, Hampton Day will require financial and City staff support; and

**WHEREAS**, as a benefit to its citizens, the City desires to co-host Hampton Day 2022 and provide the necessary support to the Main Street Board and Hampton Day, Inc. for the successful execution of the celebrations; and

**WHEREAS**, for future years, the City will add Hampton Day to its budget to ensure it is appropriately funded as a City-sponsored function.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the City Council approves the co-hosting of the 2022 Hampton Day with the Main Street Board and Hampton Day, Inc. and for Hampton Day to be deemed a City event.


