WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton has reviewed the bids in response to the City's desire to improve West Main Street Improvements Phase II ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Wilson Construction Management. is the most responsive with a cost bid for the Project as listed in **Exhibit "A"** attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City staff is recommending that the City award the ITB #2022-200 contract to Wilson Construction Management. to perform work on the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter § 2.32(4), the Mayor has authority to sign City contracts upon Council's approval; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to authorize the City Manager to contract with Wilson Construction Management. as the successful bidder and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council awards the ITB #2022-200 contract to Wilson Construction Management, authorizes the City Manager to enter into contract negotiations with Wilson Construction Management, and authorizes the Mayor to sign the contract.
