RESOLUTION NO. 2022-23

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are tasked with protecting and promoting the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton;

WHEREAS, to assist in the City's development, the City of Hampton created the Hampton Development Agency (hereinafter "HDA") whose general purpose is to develop and promote trade, commerce, industry, and employment opportunities for the public good and the general welfare and to promote the general welfare of the city and state;

WHEREAS, the HDA will carry out such purpose by and through the HDA Board (hereinafter "Board");

WHEREAS, the Board shall consist of not less than seven and more than nine members;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council must appoint members to the HDA for them to continue its business;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the Mayor and Council shall appoint the following members to the HDA Board for the term listed beside each member, and said appointments shall be effective immediately.
