RESOLUTION NO. 2022-33

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE RECONNECTING COMMUNITIES PILOT (“RCP”) DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Hampton, Georgia is the Mayor and Council (hereinafter “City”) thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City has completed its City and Henry County Transportation Plan Update and proposed therein is a Woolsey Road Major Transportation project; and

WHEREAS, the City has completed its City and Henry County Trail Plan and proposed therein is a HWY 20 Pedestrian Overpass;

WHEREAS, the Reconnecting Communities Pilot (“RCP”) Discretionary Grant Program allows cities to apply for grant funding to fund planning activities for transportation projects that reconnect communities; and

WHEREAS, there is funding available from RCP (Opportunity Number DOT-RCP-FY22-01) for which the City can apply by October 13, 2022 from the US Federal Highway Administration; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to apply for the 80/20 funding for planning activities; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his designee has the authority to complete any and all necessary application documents to apply for the RCP FY22 funding; and

WHEREAS, the City is aware of and certifies that in the event the City is recommended for said funding, the City will be responsible for twenty (20) percent of the total project cost;

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, that the City Manager or his designee is authorized to move forward with due diligence in applying for the above-referenced RCP planning grant for Woolsey Road Major Transportation project and HWY 20 Pedestrian Overpass project.
