RESOLUTION NO. 22-41

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton is a recipient of Local Option Sales Tax proceeds (hereinafter "LOST"), and such funds are shared amongst Henry County (hereinafter "County") and all Henry County cities; and

WHEREAS, the decennial census was completed in 2020 triggering the need to renegotiate the distribution of LOST proceeds; and

WHEREAS the Henry County cities conducted mediation with the County, but the parties have come to an impasse regarding the distribution of LOST proceeds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to hire a public relations consultant to assist the cities with their campaign for a fair and equitable distribution of the LOST proceeds; and


WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to join the other Henry County cities to hire Howard Franklin of Ohio River South for professional public relation services not to exceed \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Henry County cities agree to split the cost of the PR consultant commensurate with their current LOST share.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City shall join the other Henry County cities and engage Howard Franklin of Ohio River South for the purposes of a LOST public relations campaign at a rate not to exceed its current LOST share of \$50,000.00.


