**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-45**

**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE CITY OF HAMPTON’S MAIN STREET ADVISORY BOARD; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing body of the City of Hampton, Georgia (“City”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been designated as a Classic Main Street Program by the state of Georgia and nationally accredited by the National Main Street Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to meet the 10 standards for accreditation which place an emphasis on historic preservation education as well as economic development to promote an active and vibrant downtown; and

**WHEREAS**, the Main Street Advisory Board carries out their duties pursuant to the Georgia Main Street Program and the National Main Street program strategies; and

**WHEREAS**, there exists vacancies on the Main Street Advisory Board; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Main Street Board’s bylaws, the Mayor and Council must fill the vacancies.

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by a majority vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton that the Mayor and Council shall appoint the following persons who meet the Main Street Advisory Board qualifications:
