RESOLUTION NO. 22-47

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton (hereinafter "City") is governed by the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton employs a City Manager whose authority is codified in the City Code at Section 2-120; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Manager's authority, it is necessary to grant him specific authority to allow for the transfer of funds to the Hampton Housing Authority ("HHA"); and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") with the HHA to ensure that the duties of HHA are carried out in a way that is not in conflict with City policy, vision and goals and to ensure the transfer of funds is used for the specified purpose; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to allow the City Manager to transfer funds in the amount of \$2,500.00 to the HHA for the purpose of the HHA hiring legal counsel; and

WHEREAS, said legal counsel will be hired by the HHA to establish a non-profit of the HHA as detailed in the corresponding IGA; and

WHEREAS, the transferred funds in the amount of \$2,500.00 do not require a budget amendment; rather, the funds are already budgeted as professional services; and

WHEREAS, the transferred funds require reimbursement to the City pursuant to the terms in the IGA; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Manager shall have the authority to issue a check to the HHA for sole purpose of hiring legal counsel to establish a non-profit organization of the HHA; and

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the transferred funds shall be reimbursable pursuant to the terms of the IGA between the City and the HHA.




