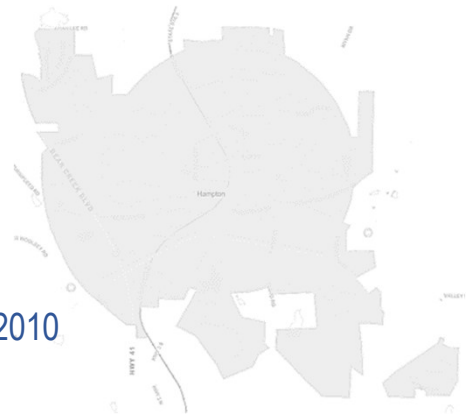

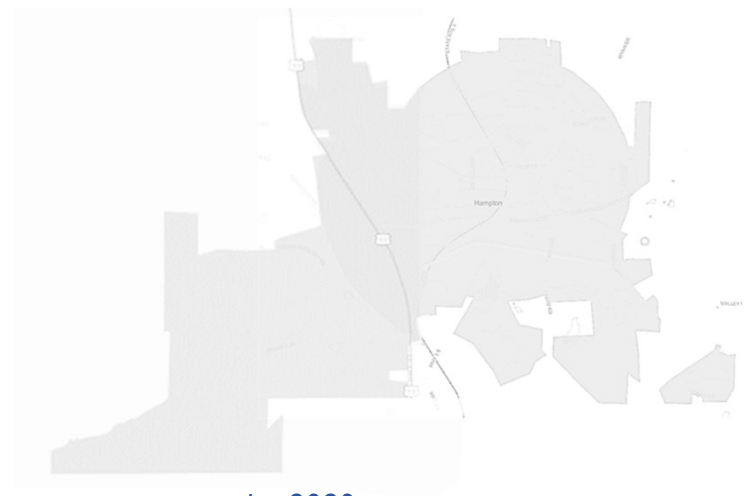

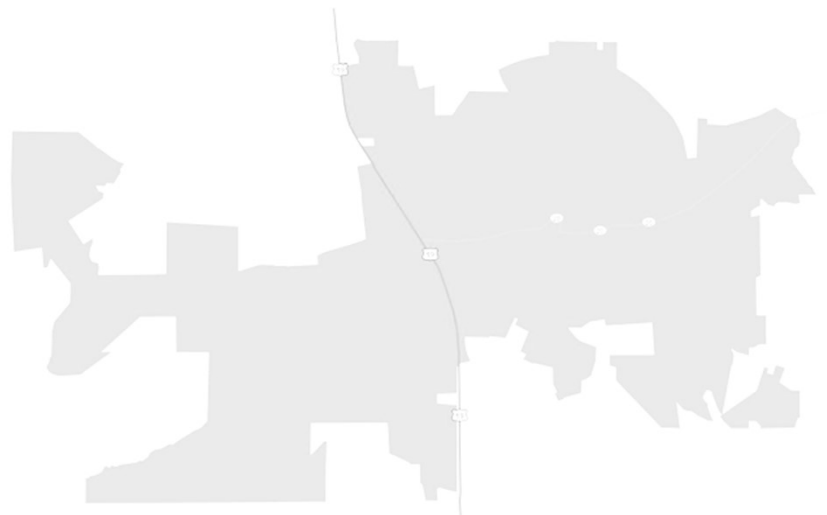
Where We Have Been: Our Story
